I'm writing this letter to strongly urge you to Deny EL 18-003. There are several concern but here's a few:

- 1) Lighting-Mr Mauersberger's testimony says that I will not only have to deal with these eyesores during the day, but the blinking lights all night as well? This is completely unacceptable! Aircraft sensing lights are a little more expensive, however if APEX is a "Good Neighbor" they claim to be a little more expense is not much to ask.
