Cody Chambliss, acting as Receiver for Plaintiff pursuant to Court Order in Case 04CIV21000037, states the following pursuant to SDCL 15-6-14:

- 1. A Judgment was entered in favor of Plaintiff on December 7, 2020.
- 2. Pursuant to Court Order in 34CIV21000037, dated August 10, 2021, I was authorized to pursue collection of outstanding accounts receivable for Plaintiff, Farmers Cooperative Elevator.
- 3. I thereafter undertook to collect on this Judgment.
- 4. Joel Namminga thereafter filed for Chapter 7 Bankruptcy and later amended that filing to be a Chapter 12 Bankruptcy, ultimately resulting in a bankruptcy plan which would make 100% payment to all creditors, including unsecured creditors, over a period of five years. Annual payment amounts will increase over the five years.
- 5. Through the Chapter 12 Trustee, Mr. Namminga has now made the Second year's payment in the amount of \$38,915.67, bring the total collection including last year's payment which has already been reflected to \$77,831.34. Therefore, I affirm that the outstanding judgment may be reduced by \$38,915.67.
