STATEMENT OF PARTIAL
SATISFACTION

Cody Chambliss, acting as Receiver for Plaintiff pursuant to Court Order in Case 04CIV21000037, states the following pursuant to SDCL 15-6-14:

1. A Judgment was entered in favor of Plaintiff on December 7, 2020.
2. Pursuant to Court Order in 34CIV21000037, dated August 10, 2021, I was authorized to pursue collection of outstanding accounts receivable for Plaintiff, Farmers Cooperative Elevator.
3. I thereafter undertook to collect on this Judgment.
4. Joel Namminga thereafter filed for Chapter 7 Bankruptcy and later amended that filing to be a Chapter 12 Bankruptcy, ultimately resulting in a bankruptcy plan which would make 100% payment to all creditors, including unsecured creditors, over a period of five years. Annual payment amounts will increase over the five years.
5. Through the Chapter 12 Trustee, Mr. Namminga has now made the first year's payment in the amount of \$38,915.67. Therefore, I affirm that the outstanding judgment has been partially satisfied and reduced by \$38,915.67.
