COMES NOW the Applicant, and supplements its motion for a protective order.

Applicant states that negotiations with the Federal Hazardous Materials Safety Administration regarding the HCA maps filed and marked confidential have resulted in Steve Fisher of the National Pipeline Mapping System indicating that the USA HCA data information can be provided to parties under the following conditions:

1. No hard or electronic copies of maps can be provided to the parties; the parties can only view the information as the eco-sensitive data set information is proprietary.
2. A list of names needs to be kept by the Applicant of who has viewed the information. The onus is on the Applicant to enforce the DOT policy.
3. Parties that view the HCA information should clearly understand that the information is eco-sensitive locations which are very specifically designated for situations which require extraordinary measures in aiding operators to develop integrity management plans.
4. If any member of the public desires the information, they are to call the Department of Transportation, National Pipeline Mapping System.

Applicant requests these conditions be attached to the viewing and use of the HCA sensitive material, if requested by any party.
