

ABSTRACT

Phase II cultural resource surveys were completed on an additional 1.25 miles (2.0 km) composed of three short segments for the Rockies Express Pipeline project (REX) in Marshall and Brown counties, Kansas. A reroute for the pipeline corridor at Buttermilk Creek in Brown County was also assessed. This report is supplemental to *A Phase II Cultural Resources Survey of the Kansas Segment of the Proposed Rockies Express Pipeline Project (REX) Corridor, Marshall, Nemaha, Brown, and Doniphan Counties, Kansas* (Myers et al. 2006). No cultural resources were located within the areas surveyed; project clearance is recommended for these parcels.
