Thank you for submitting information on the above referenced project for our review pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (P.L. 89-665, as amended) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's regulation 36 CFR Part 800, which requires identification and evaluation of cultural resources.

We have reviewed the progress report summarizing the findings for 39 miles of the 78 miles selected for survey for this project, and the Phase II testing of eleven (11) sites. Based on this review it is evident that a thorough and adequate cultural resources investigation has been conducted. We look forward to additional progress reports as the survey moves forward.
