Dear Commissioners Hanson, Nelson and Fiegen:

I am writing to urge you to reject the Keystone XL Pipeline certification in docket HP14-001.

I believe that the risks this pipeline and its construction pose to the health, safety, and security of South Dakota's water, land, and people are unacceptable. The final Environmental Impact Statement submitted by the State Department shows the pipeline is *expected* to leak at least ten times over the course of its lifetime. **Expected!**

South Dakotans shouldn't be willing to sacrifice and risk the Missouri River, the Ogallala Aquifer, our rural water systems, and our livelihoods for dirty tarsands oil—especially when that oil is meant primarily for export. Moreover the construction of the pipeline puts rural communities at risk with the drastic influx of people, equipment, and traffic.

For these reasons and more than I can possibly recite in a brief email, reject Keystone XL.
