This is in response to your letter regarding the Dakota Access Pipeline permit application filed with the commission, docket HP14-002.

The answers to your questions are found in the online docket which you can access by going to the PUC website at www.puc.sd.gov. Click on Commission Actions, Commission Dockets, Hydrocarbon Pipeline Dockets, and 2014 Hydrocarbon Pipeline Dockets. The Final Decision and Order is on the website, under the Orders subhead. The portions of this 25-page document you will want to reference include the parties involved, and the findings related to impacts on cultural resources (Findings of Fact 95-99, with 98 explaining consultation with tribes). You can also read the 70 Permit Conditions referenced in the Order.
