Pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-15 and 49-41B-16, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) will hold public input hearings at the above times and locations on an Application for an Energy Facility Permit filed December 15, 2014, by Dakota Access, LLC (Applicant) for the Dakota Access Pipeline Project (Application). The Application requests Commission approval of a permit to construct a 12-inch to 30-inch pipeline across approximately 271.6 miles in South Dakota for the purpose of transporting crude oil (Project). The line will cross the South Dakota and North Dakota border in Campbell County, South Dakota and extend south and east through McPherson, Edmunds, Faulk, Spink, Beadle, Kingsbury, Miner, Lake, McCook, Minnehaha, Turner, and Lincoln Counties, exiting South Dakota at the South Dakota/Iowa border in Lincoln County. The proposed pipeline will have an initial capacity of 450,000 barrels of oil per day (bpd)

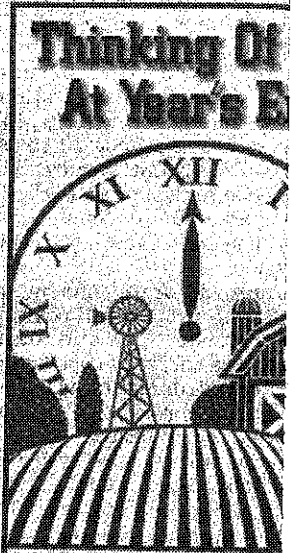
with an anticipated capacity of approximately 450,000 bpd. The Project includes a pump station located approximately 10 miles southeast of Bowdle, South Dakota.

At the public hearing, the applicant will present a description of the project, which interests may be affected, and present views, and conduct the Application pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-15. 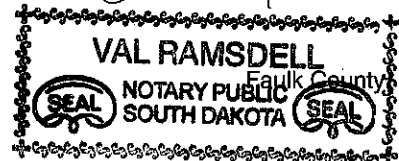
