NOTICE OF SOUTH DAKOTA PUC PERMIT CONDITION 39

On December 14, 2015, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission granted a facility permit to Dakota Access, LLC a subsidiary of Energy Transfer Partners, LP, to construct and operate the Dakota Access Pipeline Project. The Dakota Access pipeline will be a 30-inch diameter crude oil pipeline connecting the Bakken and Three Forks production areas in North Dakota with existing crude oil infrastructure in Illinois. Condition 39 of the 2015 permit states as follows:

"At the request of any landowner or public water supply system that offers to provide the necessary access to Dakota Access over his/her property or easement(s) to perform the necessary work, Dakota Access shall replace at no cost to such landowner or public water supply system, any polyethylene water piping located within 500 feet of the Project with piping that is resistant to permeation by BTEX. Dakota Access shall not be required to replace that portion of any piping that passes through under a basement or other wall of a home or other structure."
