- a) if the Project needs approval from an agency for crossing parcels enrolled in CRP or other conservation programs and when the Project plans to file for such approval, and
- b) The counties the Project needs to obtain CUPs from.

## **Updated** Response:

- a) SCS Carbon Transport LLC (SCS) has identified the following locations where landowners have entered into an easement with the NRCS. Additionally, SCS requests information from the Farm Service Agency quarterly to keep up with changes in the route and the next delivery of information will be provided by the end of Q3 2023. SCS will work with each landowner on the crossing of the easement to either ensure that reclamation meets the easement requirements or provide the landowner with compensation to reimburse the federal government.

- b) The counties with aboveground facilities such as pump stations will require a conditional use permit: Minnehaha, Beadle, Brown, and McPherson.
