In recent meetings, the Commissioners have inquired or made comments about lawsuits in which the Project is a party. In some, the Project is a defendants; in others, it is a plaintiff. In all cases to date, the underlying controversy is one regarding what the law is and what the law says about a party's rights and responsibilities vis a vis the project. We think that asking a court to review the law and declare rights and responsibilities is a legitimate endeavor for anyone.

In any event, Judge Pardy in the Third Circuit recently issued the attached opinion letter which has been distributed to other judges considering the same questions. We are attaching it here for the information of Commissioners and other parties as well.
