I was in receipt of email communications from Senator Schoenbeck on Saturday, February 26, similar to those he posted in the docket contemporaneously.

I immediately inquired of the SCS project development team. We determined that same Saturday morning that the proposed route to which the Senator was reacting had been significantly altered some months ago and no longer impacted the property about which he was speaking and concerned. We communicated that back immediately and followed up with a number of individuals, including the entire Watertown legislative delegation, the Mayor, and the priority. All indications were that everyone was satisfied and that the matter is no longer at issue. If we learn otherwise, we will communicate with everyone affected.

As of this writing, we believe there to be no issue remaining, regarding the one communicated on February 26.
