Based upon Applicant's best efforts to decipher SCS Carbon Transport, LLC ("SCS") confusing maps purportedly showing the "proposed project route" that fail to include any landowner names, Applicant owns, farms, and/or has an interest in real property that would be directly and substantially negatively affected should the Commission vote to approve SCS's Permit for its proposed liquified carbon dioxide pipeline as the Commissions' approval is the triggering factor for eminent domain action and SCS's taking of Applicants property rights. Until SCS files a detailed list of all owners of land it intends to construct its pipeline across, neither Applicant, nor any other potentially affected person can be sure if they need to incur legal expenses to exercise their due process rights and intervene in this Docket. Applicant seeks Party Status out of abundance of caution.
