

Glacial Lakes Energy, LLC, a South Dakota LLC, on behalf of itself and as sole manager of its sister entities Huron Energy, LLC, Aberdeen Energy, LLC, and Hub City Energy, LLC ("Glacial Lakes"), hereby petitions for intervention pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:15.02. Glacial Lakes Corn Processors, a South Dakota cooperative with approximately 4,500 members in South Dakota, is the parent company and 100% owner of Glacial Lakes. Glacial Lakes operates four ethanol plants located in Codington, Brown, Edmunds and Beadle Counties and would intend to connect its facilities with the carbon dioxide transmission pipeline to be constructed by SCS Carbon Transport, LLC. The future viability of Glacial Lakes, its plants, and its 4,500 producer owner members would be significantly enhanced by the carbon sequestration opportunity presented by the pending application. Glacial Lakes and its 4,500 producer owner members will be directly impacted by the outcome of the proceeding before the commission.
