I have told Navigator that I am not interested in their proposed offer for lease of easement. But I received a letter about surveying said land. Can they survey land they do not own and do not have permission to lease? What are my rights. I do not want a pipeline thru my property today or ever.

I realize I am at the mercy of Summit because they are not actually going thru my property.

Will Navigator be able to force their pipeline thru my property? Ethanol plants and pipeline companies are profiting at the expense of landowners. I do own ethanol stock and do not wish to profit from the landowners, myself included. It is not about profit when it comes down to it, I do not want the risk of a pipeline thru my land.
