To whom it may concern:

I am very concerned and opposed to the rapid acquisition attempt by Summit Carbon Solutions for easement rights for the proposed CO2 carbon capture and sequestration pipeline through South Dakota, and especially in Spink County where I am the fourth generation owner and steward of my family farm.

I request the PUC not approve the permit for this project at this time. Instead, time is needed for information gathering and assurance to landowners and community residents for our safety concerns, the impact on the community and landowners alike, and adequate compensation for affected landowners and community resources.

Many of us have legitimate questions and concerns related to landowner protections; indemnification in event of disasters, leaks, lost production past the initial three years, the impact of heavy equipment on pipeline buried at a minimum depth avoiding needing to shore trenches, the impact on insurance we are required to carry on production land, and the questions continue.

I request the PUC deny the permit for SCS until community and landowner questions and concerns are satisfactorily addressed.
