Commissioners Hansen, Nelson and Acting Commissioner Haeder:

In regard to the Summit pipeline, I strongly encourage you to delay the formal permitting process to address the many concerns you heard at the recent Commission sponsored public meetings.

**Until** new federal PHMSA guidelines and state legislation is adopted, a postponement of the permitting process is a prudent course of action. I encourage you to consider listening to affected landowners and schedule September of 2023 or January of 2024 Summit CO 2 PUC official permitting hearings.

The intention of the CO 2 pipeline industry is to use the calendar to dodge new PHMSA rules. It is nothing more than an attempt to escape regulation that is in the public's best interest.

Holding hearings in the April-May 2023 time frame does a great disservice to affected rural homeowners and landowners heavily involved in agriculture with lambing, calving and planting time frame concerns. It would create an additional unnecessary burden on

affected landowners. The April meeting dates would make them choose between their livelihoods and the pipeline hearings. This is wrong.
