As a landowner in SD I am writing this letter to oppose the final word you have on granting the permit for Summit Carbon.

My land is not for sale and I don't feel a **Private** company has the right to eminent domain when it is not for public but only used for big profits for their company. The people at the meeting in Lincoln county are definitely against this project and we don't want to be responsible for hazardous waste, deaths, and destruction of land and animals if the pipeline leaks. They say they offer a fair price but are completely out of line as I talked to my brother who has a farm they want to cross in Iowa. They need to be denied the permit in Lincoln county and stay out of our state.

In the long run Ethanol plants will be closing as we will need the corn and beans to go to a food source for our country. Too much farmland is already being bought up by foreign entity and also for our cities expanding in every direction. Our farm land is precious and not for sale. Deny this permit. I am unable to attend the meeting March 23<sup>rd</sup> in Sioux Falls as I have to be out of the area for the next 3 weeks.
