Thank you, Mr. Nelson, again for your expanded explanation. My contention is that your 4) "not unduly interfere with the orderly development of the region..." would definitely be grounds to deny trenching in a liquefied CO2 pipeline where the city of Sioux Falls will grow over it IF allowed to be trenched in within 5 miles of the City Limit in northern Lincoln County.

IF the pipeline would rupture, the expressed CO2 would "pose a threat of serious injury to the environment nor to the social and economic condition of inhabitants or expected inhabitants in the siting area" as noted in 2) and also "substantially impair the health, safety or welfare of the inhabitants" as noted in 3) as well.

I have already sent the same e-mail to District 6 Legislators.
