Dear PUC Commissioner,

I am confused that we have a law in South Dakota that contradicts the Supreme Law of the Land as outlined in our U.S. Constitution. The U.S. Constitution states that "No person shall... be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation." This phraseology, that is contained within the fifth amendment, lays out the duty of the government to protect private property and how it may lawfully take land for public use. However, South Dakota law states that, "Any pipeline companies owning a pipeline which is a common carrier as defined ... may exercise the right of eminent domain in acquiring right-of-way as prescribed." (SDCL § 49-7-13) I believe that this South Dakota law violates the U.S. Constitution and should have been changed during this last legislative session. House Bill 1133 would have done this. However, it did not pass. Since it did not pass, it is up to you, as a PUC Commissioner, to put a stop to these illegal attempts at using eminent domain by private companies seeking to build a CO2 pipeline through South Dakota. Please do everything you possibly can to protect landowners from these companies who are trying to bully them out of their land! Please encourage all South Dakota legislators, and the governor, to stop these companies and protect South Dakota farmers and ranchers.

Biotechnology start-up Deep Branch have designed a biochemical transformation process that turns carbon dioxide (CO2) into a protein-rich powder for animals to eat.

The Deep Branch process converts carbon dioxide into a powder, called Proton, which has around 70% protein content. This is much higher than natural soy, which has around 40%.
