On September 27, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an Application for a Permit under the South Dakota Energy Conversion and Transmission Facilities Act to Construct the Heartland Greenway Pipeline in South Dakota (Application) from Navigator Heartland Greenway, LLC, a limited liability company owned by Navigator CO2 Ventures LLC (Navigator or Applicant). Applicant proposes to construct and operate a carbon dioxide (CO2) transmission pipeline (Project). The Project is approximately 1,300 miles of pipelines for the transportation of CO2 from more than 21 ethanol and fertilizer plants across 5 states, including 3 ethanol plants in South Dakota, that will transport captured carbon dioxide for permanent and secure underground sequestration in Illinois and/or to off-take facilities for commercial/industrial use. The Project consists of 111.9 miles of carbon dioxide pipeline in South Dakota that will cross the counties of Brookings, Moody, Minnehaha, Lincoln, and Turner.

On September 29, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of November 28, 2022, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. On September 30, 2022, the Commission issued an Amended Notice of Application; Order for and Notice of Public Input Meeting; Notice of Opportunity to Apply for Party Status. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:22:40, the deadline for persons to file an application for party status is November 28, 2022. On October 28, 2022, the Commission granted party status to the South Dakota Telecommunications Association and the Brookings County Commission. On November 21 and 22, 2022, the Commission held public input meetings in Canton, Flandreau, and Sioux Falls. On December 7, 2022, the Commission issued an order granting party status. On December 28, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Granting Party Status to Gwen Reker and Dave Larson. On January 10, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Granting Motion to Set Discovery Response Deadline; Order Granting Motion to Require Prefiled Testimony; Order to Hold Prehearing Scheduling Conference. On January 17, 2023, the Commission received an Application for Party Status from Lesley Pedde. On January 19, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Setting Procedural Schedule.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-41B, specifically 49-41B-17, and ARSD Chapter 20:10:22, specifically 20:10:22:40.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on January 27, 2023, the Commission considered the late-filed Application for Party Status. With no objections from Navigator, Commission staff, or the other parties, the Commission voted unanimously to grant Party Status to Lesley Pedde.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that Party Status is hereby granted to Lesley Pedde.
