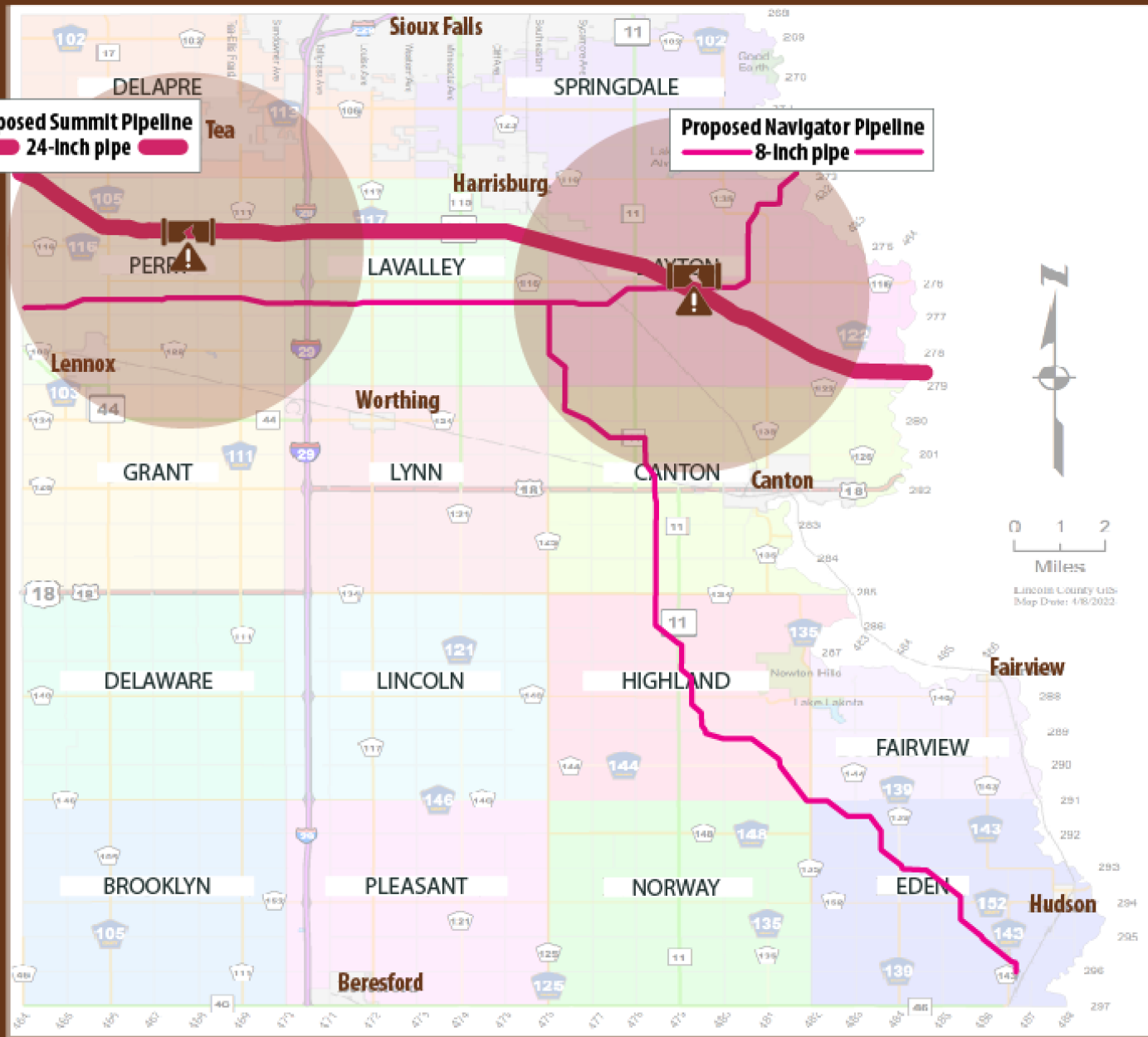


Lincoln County – Potential Impact Area from Rupture ~ 4.5-mile radius*



Are you willing to risk public safety for corporate profits?

Burden of proof should be on companies to conduct and release plume modeling to adequately disclose risk to decision makers, landowners and public.

Without access to an impact or rupture model study for the proposed lines, this map was developed by concerned landowners utilizing a published study modeling impact of potential rupture of a 12.5" CO2 pipeline.

- Impact zone was up to 4.5-mile radius.
- 12.5" line from the study is slightly larger than currently proposed 8" line by Navigator.
- 12.5" line is only approx. one third the volume of 24" line proposed by Summit.

Rupture could have much broader impact and consequences beyond proposed setbacks for landowners.
