MOTION TO RECONSIDER APPLICANT'S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE

COMES NOW, the Applicant, by and through its counsel of record, and moves the Commission for an order reconsidering the Commission's April 10 decision on Applicant's March 12 Motion to Extend Deadlines.

Applicant makes said Motion in response to the Commission's Request that Applicant

Present a Plan and in order to give the Commission the opportunity to fully consider the

Applicant's plan which is under development and will be presented in writing later this week.

Without a Motion from the Applicant to Extend Deadlines, the Commission seems to be less

able, if able at all, to act upon the Plan which the Commission requested at its April 10 meeting.

Moreover, the motion made at the meeting was not a simple denial of the motion as stated in the written order entered yesterday. From the recording of the meeting, the motion was as follows: "I move in HP24-001 that the Commission deny suspending the current scheduling order except to approve and amend the Commission's order dated January 31st, 2025 to now state that discovery responses may be due 45 calendar days from the receipt of discovery request and delete the number 15 and to request the applicant to present a plan moving forward to the PUC at the next Commission meeting, and to move to deny extending indefinitely the current deadline for the Commission's actions on Docket HP24-001." To the extent that the order is inconsistent with the motion that was approved at the meeting, the order should be amended to be consistent with the motion that was approved.

Whereupon, the Applicant asks that the Commission grant this Motion to Reconsider and then go on to grant the March 12 motion.
