My property, which includes 200 acres of pasture and 200 grazing cows, is 30-50 ft lower than the proposed pipeline area, creating serious risks as CO2 is heavier than air. Summit's proposed siting will endanger the health, safety, and welfare of those using this lower land. The farm headquarters is 1/2 a mile east of section 30. The lower land poses a significant hazard to my cattle and heirs.

Additionally, the pipeline crosses under 147th Street, a critical route for heavy farm equipment and trucks. A four-foot-deep pipeline cannot handle the road stress.

I've found no credible science supporting the UN's designation of carbon dioxide as a pollutant. This claim is false and needs to end.
