I received notification of this pending project ("packet") without any details provided describing the land affected (e.g., parcel, route) nor the facilities to be installed or work area/access needed for installation. Further, no easement template was provided for consideration. The packet simply included a W-9 and a survey access form along with several pages of marketing material. The permit applicant is not being forthright in their approach with the landowners. As trustee of this farmland legacy trust, I have no interest subjecting future generations to the terms and conditions that come with this hazardous material pipeline, the impact of which to the land is impossible to know regarding long-term value, potential damages, and zoning risk limiting potential uses over the next century. I am asking the PUC to take into consideration the long-term consequences of this project in the permitting process.
