## Explain your interest:

The proposed hazardous waste supercritical CO2 pipeline that will run through our highly erodible land (HEL) will cut two Soil and Water Conservation terraces and cause unforgivable erosion after decades of no-till practices. Our family has owned this land for over 125 years and has an intense interest in this project since it will cause a direct economic hit. Summit CANNOT restore no-till land and has no interest in lowa farmland. Their sole goal in this project is billions of dollars that will benefit them - a private company and private gain at our expense. Under SDCL §1-26-27.1, a person whose pecuniary interest would be directly and immediately affected by an agency's order may become a party to the hearing. Our family's land will be adversely affected by an approved permit from the South Dakota PUC since the Iowa IUC granted eminent domain with the approved permit to Summit Carbon. The sixth and seventh generation are waiting in the wings to inherit the land, but we may not be able to pass this precious land on to our family due to the fact that we will no longer be covered by liability insurance, and they could be sued into bankruptcy.
