I am submitting a written comment for the HP24-001 proposal.

My land is in Brown County, NE 1/4, Section 12, Township 122, Range 64 West of the 5th P.M. I have been notified of Summit's intent to have the pipeline come through my land. I am not necessarily opposed to the pipeline coming through my land, but as the owner I will have the right and final say as to the location and route the pipeline runs through my land. If Summit does not agree with my route, then I will oppose and decline any attempt to negotiate an easement agreement with them.
