Subject: [EXT] Comments for Docket Number HP24-001 - Summit Carbon Solutions Carbon Dioxide Pipeline

South Dakota Public Utilities Commission:

I am submitting a written comment for the HP24-001 proposal.

My land is in Brown County, NE 1/4, Section 12, Township 122, Range 64 West of the 5th P.M. I have been notified of Summit's intent to have the pipeline come through my land. I am not necessarily opposed to the pipeline coming through my land, but as the owner **I will have the right and final say** as to the location and route the pipeline runs through my land. If Summit does not agree with my route, **then I will oppose and decline any attempt to negotiate an easement agreement with them.**

I recently had the Brown County Conservation District plant over 4,500 trees for a wildlife habitat project program with the South Dakota Game, Fish, and Parks. Since Summit's current proposed route comes through part of that habitat project, I will not agree to that pipeline route through my land. Summit's only potential opportunity to route that pipeline through my land is to agree to the route that I propose as the landowner, otherwise I will oppose and not allow them access to my land.
