We live in NW Woodbury County, Iowa. This is a tri-state area (IA,NE,SD) in which a decision in one state directly affects the others. Summit Carbon Solutions proposed their hazardous CO2 pipeline to the public in 2021 and since that time has met considerable opposition. In Iowa attempting to squash that opposition, Summit has sued counties, sued landowners, and most recently sent cease & desist letters to vocal opponents. To garner support from our Iowa Utility Commission, letters entered into the docket had out of state addresses with Iowa zip codes to appear they were written by Iowa residents. Summit themselves were sued by the Welspun Corp for 15 million dollars due to a canceled contract. I can't imagine there is any reason that Summit would be a good business partner.
