PUC,

The Dayton township board would like to enter their comments for consideration by the PUC and any other govt agency/group in regards to any and all CO2 pipeline projects/plans.

The Dayton township board of supervisors, upon hearing about the potential of one or more CO2 pipeline route plans to cross into Dayton township, attended meetings and conducted research on CO2 pipelines. We (the Dayton Township BOS) then advertised in our legal newspaper our plan to adopt a CO2 pipeline ordinance. After the wait period, we voted and implemented CO2 pipeline ordinance 23-01(attached) for the regulation of carbon dioxide pipelines that could potentially be installed in Dayton township. This ordinance was also given to the Lincoln County courthouse to have on file in January 2024.

This ordinance was established to protect the electors of Dayton township and their properties. We trust that you will support our ordinance if any co2 pipeline is approved.
