This is Jim Eschenbaum, Chairman of SDPRLCA - Referred Law 21.

As I'm sure you are aware, 242,459 South Dakotans, 59% of RL21 voters, 65 of 66 Counties, agreed with your original ruling on this pipeline issue that local governments have the authority to put zoning ordinances in place, and enforce said ordinances for the safety of their citizens.

I see in this application for a permit that the applicant is asking the Commission to override any zoning that they can't comply with. To do so the Commission would have to admit that their original denial was somehow wrong or incorrect.
