TEOCO does not agree with the denial. These were ordered with a PIU of 0 meaning the rates should be billed from the Intrastate Tariff. Venture is listed as a LECA company on the PUC website of South Dakota. In section 17.2.4 of the LECA tariff it states that "the company will mirror the interstate access rates found in Section 17.2 of the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA). Please advise why Venture Communication is billing rates from the General Exchange Tariff and not NECA.

[1] The Company specific rates are based on the rules outlined in 47 CFR 51.909 of the FCC Rules and Regulations. As a member of the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., the company will mirror the interstate access rates found in Section 17.2 of the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., F.C.C. Tariff No. 5.
