On March 22, 2021, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a formal Complaint from Anne Marie Jordan, (Complainant), Hot Springs, South Dakota, regarding the electric billing practices of Historic Log Cabins, (Respondent), Hot Springs, South Dakota.

On March 25, 2021, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the answer deadline of April 12, 2021, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. On April 9, 2021, Respondent filed an Answer to the Complaint. On June 3, 2021, Respondent filed a letter notifying the Commission that they would discontinue billing for electricity.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A and ARSD 20:10:01:08.01, 20:10:01:09, and 20:10:01:10.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on June 22, 2021, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended dismissing the complaint and closing the docket because the billing concerns were resolved. The Complainant agreed with Commission staff's recommendation. Respondent did not appear. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the Complaint and to close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Complaint is hereby dismissed, and the docket is closed.
