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IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF OTTER TAIL POWER COMPANY FOR. AN INCREASE IN ITS ELECTRIC RATES IN SOUTH DAKOTA. ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT <u>ACREEMENT AND TARIFFS</u> (F-3691) (F-3647-5)

On June 30, 1987, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for an increase in retail electric rates. The Company's application, based on an adjusted test year ending December 31, 1986, purported to support a required annual revenue increase of \$1,013,493.

By Order dated July 17, 1987, the Commission established the procedural schedule for intervention, filing of testimony and hearing in this docket.

There were no intervenors in this proceeding. The Public Utilities Commission Staff's (Staff) filed response to OTP's application supported a rate increase producing annual revenues of no more than \$51,092.

As a result of informal negotiations held between OTP and Staff, it was agreed that OTP would file revised rate schedules designed to produce an increase in OTP's base rate levels (excluding energy clause adjustments and sales taxes) of \$341,228 on an annual basis for electric service, effective November 1, 1987. A condition of the Settlement Agreement is that OTP will not put into effect any rate changes which increase the settlement base rate level prior to January 1, 1990. Furthermore, Staff agreed to end its investigation on the effects of the TRA-86 on OTP's operations (Docket F-3647-5).

ORDERED, that the settlement reached between OTP and the Commission Staff in this matter be and the same hereby is approved upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that said tariff sheets be and the same hereby are approved upon the terms and conditions set forth therein and shall be effective for service rendered on and after the 1st day of November, 1987.
