ORDER SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE OF RATE INCREASE AND TARIFF CHANGES EL95-011

On May 16, 1995, Midwest Power, a division of Midwest Power Systems, Inc. (Midwest) filed with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for approval to increase its rates for electric service and change tariffs. The proposed effective date for the rates was August 1, 1995. An intervention deadline has been set for June 30, 1995.

Commission Staff has moved to suspend the effective date of said rate increase pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-14 to permit continued analysis of the application. Midwest Power did not resist the motion.

The Commission hereby finding sufficient cause for granting a suspension of the effective date of the increase hereby

ORDERS that the effective date of the rate increase and tariff change which are the subject of this docket shall be suspended for a period of ninety days from and after August 1, 1995.
