
Dear Mr. Bullard:

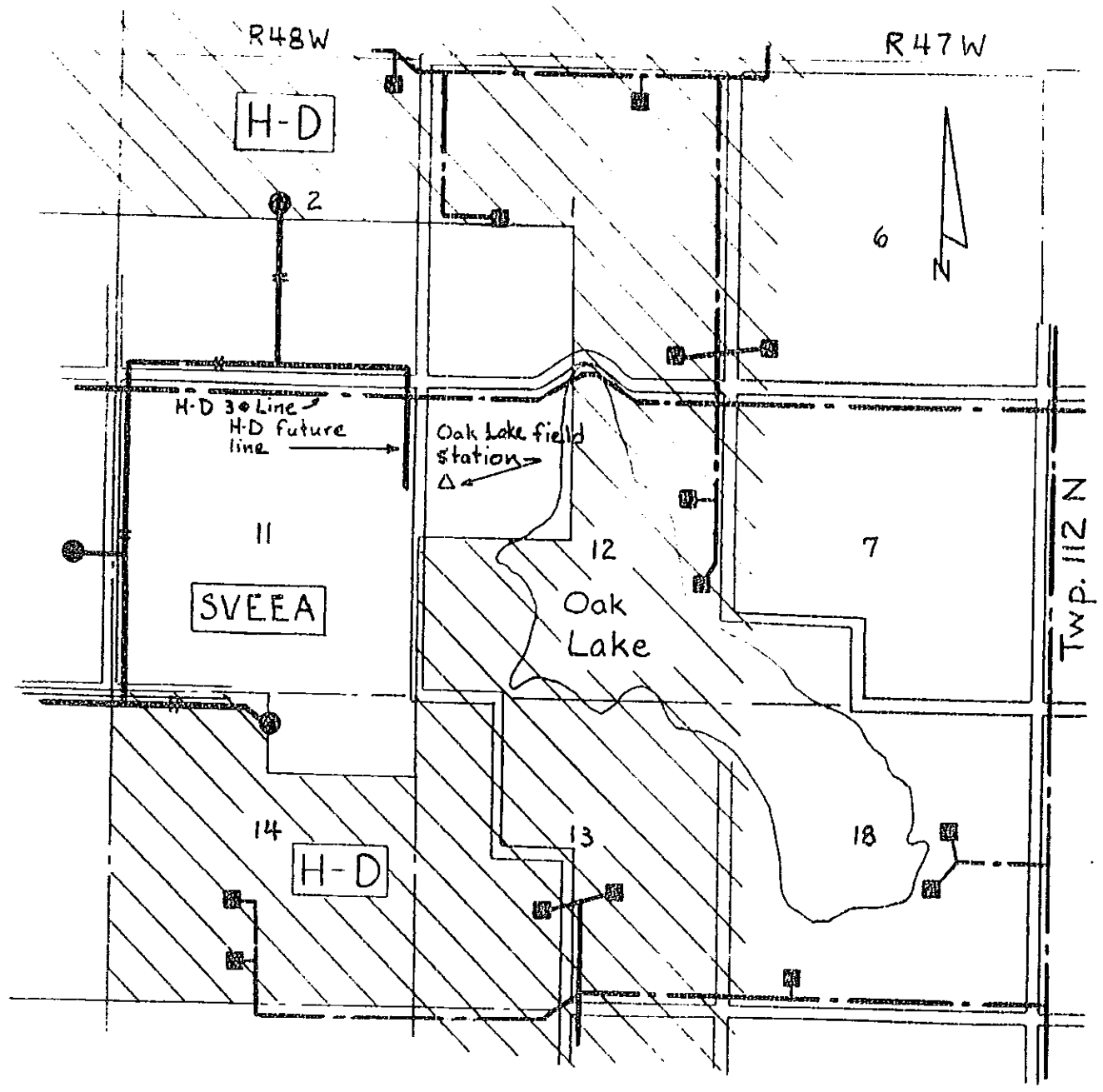

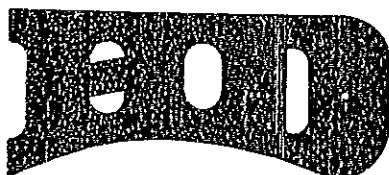


Gentlemen:

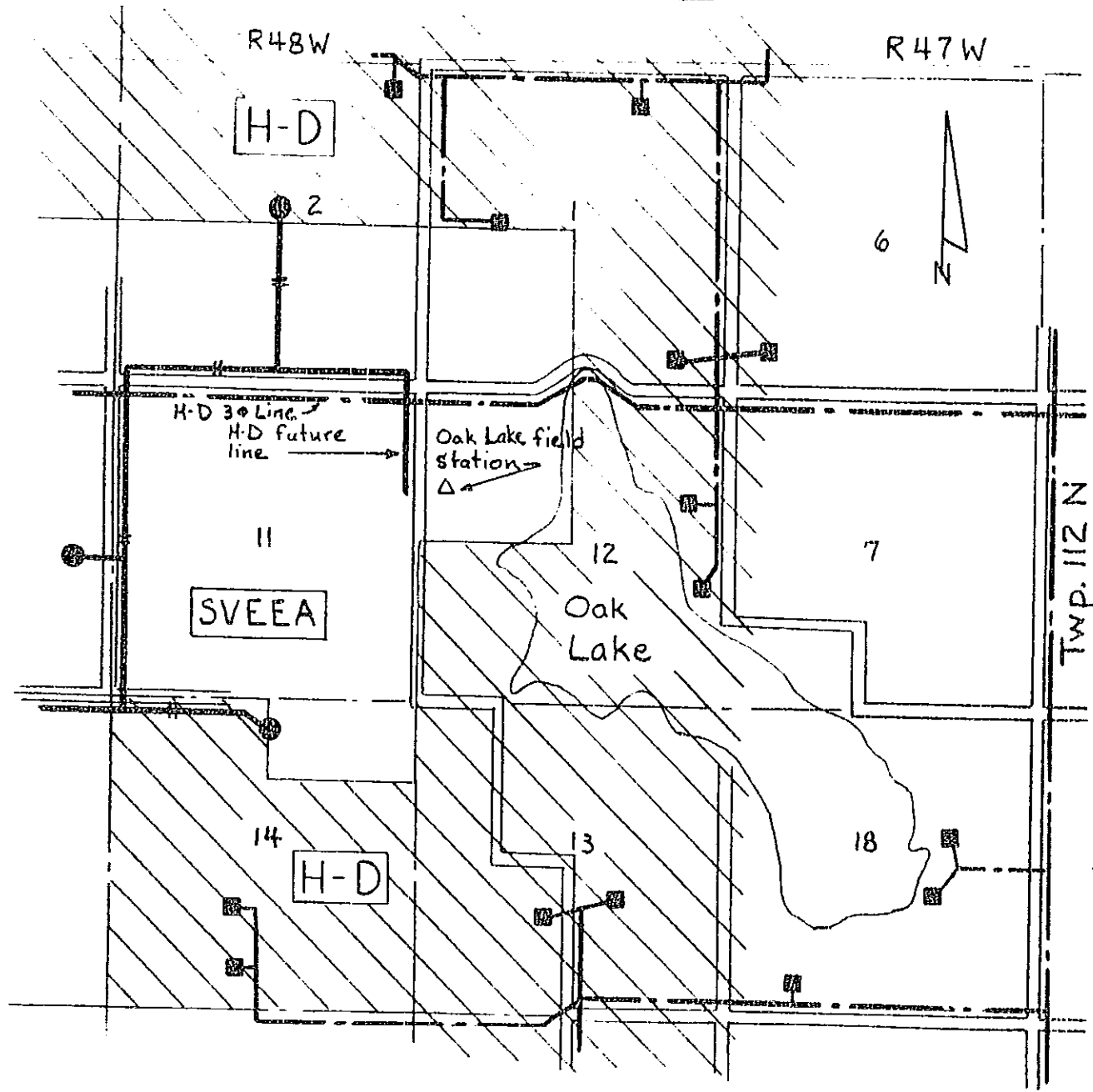
