On September 21 and September 25, 1995, H-D Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Sioux Valley Electric, respectively, each filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a Joint Request for Electric Service Territory Exception signed by both entities. The agreement will allow H-D Electric to service a South Dakota State University biology field station within Sioux Valley's territory. The parties represent that this territory exception will better serve the consumer in this instance.

The site of the Oak Lake Field Station is in the northwest quarter of Section 17, Township 112 North, Range 48 West in Brookings County, South Dakota. The director of the Oak Lake Field Station has consented to this agreement.

The Commission has jurisdiction regarding service territories pursuant to Chapter 49-34A, SDCL and to approve territorial agreements pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-42 therefore it is

ORDERED that this agreement be approved and the docket closed.
