

Project Cost

- More than \$1 billion in 2011 dollars

Project Site Selection

- 38 potential sites
- Short list for further investigation
- Big Stone site chosen

Project Schedule

- Assumes permits are received
- Site mobilization Spring 2007
- Site work start Summer 2007
- Steel erection 2008
- Boiler and turbine erection begin late 2008
- Balance of Plant (BOP) 2009
- System completion, check out and commissioning 2010
- Commercial operation Spring 2011

Primary Fuel

- Powder River Basin sub-bituminous coal
- Delivery by BNSF Railroad

Alternative Energy Resources

- Screening of options based on three basic objectives:
 - The technology must be applicable;
 - The facility must be available for service when needed;
 - The facility should enhance the overall reliability of the electric system.
- For alternatives that pass these objectives screening based on:
 - Cost, economic effects and environmental impacts
