The territory transfer between the City of Elk Point and Union County Electric Cooperative for the property described in the "Agreement for Sale of Property and Transfer of Service Territory Between the City of Elk Point and Union County Electric Cooperative Inc." does not include the purchase of any permanent facilities currently owned by Union County Electric. There were no facilities on the property at the time the transfer was negotiated.


The territory being transferred is owned solely by Kum & Go, L.C. and they are the only customer currently affected by this transfer

Kum & Go, L.C. petitioned the City of Elk Point to be annexed into city limits. Since this territory had no electric system facilities at the time of transfer, there is no unnecessary duplication of facilities. The City of Elk Point is able to provide adequate service to the affected customer and will promote the efficient use and development of the new electrical facilities.

Please find enclosed a revised Exhibit A with the traded territory outlined in purple and a revised territory map showing Elk Point's previous territory boundary in green and the new territory boundary in purple.


