AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE TERRITORY EXCEPTION

Sioux Valley Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc., doing business as Sioux Valley Energy (SVE) and Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. agree to an exception to the SVE electric service territory permitting to provide electric service to a new rural service in the Northwest quarter of Section 7, Township 105 North, Range 54 West, in Lake County, South Dakota. 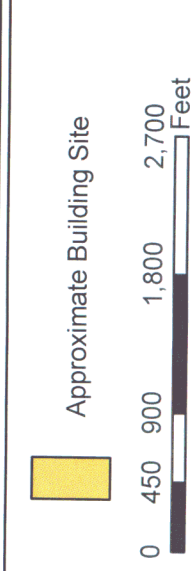
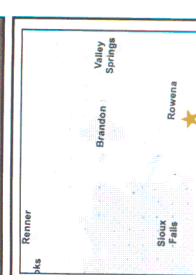
