As provided in the Settlement Stipulation, dated June 1, 2011, to the above reference docket, Black Hills Power agreed to make an annual Environmental Improvement Adjustment (EIA) filing by February 15th of each year for any additional projected environmental capital costs, expenses and recoveries. Black Hills Power will not be seeking additional recoveries for environmental projects in 2012.

Black Hills Power intends to make a filing no later than April 30th of this year to reflect actual financial information for the period of April 1, 2011 through March 31, 2012 for the Wyodak plant's environmental project costs and recoveries approved in the above reference docket.
