In accordance with that agreement, and as a result of a recent annexation to the City of Watertown, we are providing the following service territory boundary change between Codington Clark and Watertown:

Lot 4 of Endres East First Addition in Government Lot 3 and 4, less the Westerly 95.75 feet +/- of the Northerly 731.83 feet +/- of Government Lot 3, currently known as an Easterly portion of Lot 4, Endres East First Addition, all in the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, T116N, R52W, 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Codington County, South Dakota.

Attached is the resolution for annexation of the area, a vicinity map and a plat showing Lot 4 of Endres East First Addition to identify the new boundary to be added.

We would jointly request that this parcel be included as part of the Municipal Utilities territory and the PUC territorial map be adjusted to reflect this boundary change.

## A Resolution for Annexing Lot 4 of Endres East First Addition to the City of Watertown, Codington County, South Dakota




