**TEMPORARY PERMIT TO USE PUBLIC WATERS
FOR CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES**

This temporary permit to use public waters for construction purposes is issued to Rosendin Electric Inc., 2698 Orchard Pkwy, San Jose CA authorizing withdrawal of 210,000 gallons of water at a maximum rate of 264 gallons per minute from stock dams located in Section 24, T10N, R7E in Butte County. Water will be used during construction of the Willow Creek Wind Farm near Newell SD.

This temporary permit becomes effective June 10, 2020 and expires on August 14, 2020.

This permit does not provide necessary right-of-way. Such arrangements should be made with the proper landowner.

Issuance of this temporary permit deals with the withdrawal of water only. It does not address other concerns or permitting issues from other State or Federal entities.
