Dear Ms. Chamley:

The South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) reviewed Croell, Inc.'s General Air Quality Notice of Intent and determined the operations are eligible for coverage under the general permit for concrete plants. Therefore, I have enclosed Croell, Inc.'s permit to operate the portable concrete plant listed in the Notice of Intent. Croell, Inc. will be authorized to operate under permit #28.000066. DENR will conduct inspections to ensure that this facility remains in compliance with South Dakota's Air Pollution Control Regulations.

Since the general permit for concrete plant covers a variety of equipment, some of which Croell, Inc. does not operate, DENR would like to explain which chapters Croell, Inc. is required to comply with and which ones are not applicable.

Chapters 1.0 through 8.0 of the general permit for concrete plants are applicable to the following operations:

1. Portable Concrete Plants
2. Cement Silo
3. Flyash Silo

If the facility operates in the Rapid City Natural Events Action Plan area, the portable concrete plant would be applicable to Chapter 12.0 in the general permit for concrete plants.

Croell, Inc. is not subject to the permit conditions in following chapters in the general permit for concrete plants:

1. Chapter 9.0
2. Chapter 10.0
3. Chapter 11.0

Croell, Inc. must notify DENR of any changes to the equipment listed in the Notice of Intent or of additional equipment prior to making the change or installing the new equipment to ensure this facility is still eligible for coverage under the general permit.
