I live on [REDACTED]. I own 1284 acres in woodland and spring valley twp. this is in the heart of the purpose crocker wind farm. CWF offered to put 11 tower's on this land with a yearly lease payment of \$[REDACTED]. I declined. I have farmed for over 60 year's through good times and bad times and never once have I destroyed the environment or the well being of my neighbors to make a living and I don't intend to now.

As the number of intervenors has increased from 43 to 64 the tensions in the community has also increased, family's against family's, neighbors against neighbors. This should never have happened, it is so sad, I wish it would all just go away.

There are only two main north,south roads that run through the middle of the county they pass through the purpose crocker wind farm. These roads connect the north part of the county to the county seat. These roads are gravel, built many, many years ago and are not designed to carry heavy traffic which will occur with this many towers. Disruption of commercial grain trucks and cattle trucks and emergency vehicles is a real possibility.

Northern Clark county is a prime duck and goose hunting area. Wildlife disappear in and around the footprint of these wind farms. This would be a recreationally and economic lose to the county.

I respectfully request that these permits be denied to the crocker wind farm
