
#### Community project description:

The last major renovation of our City pool was over 14 years ago. The steps into the pool and the decking around the pool are all in need of replacement due to crumbling cement. There are cracks in the bottom of the pool that need to be repaired as well. Because the City of Canistota is committed to the children and adults in our community as well as the surrounding communities, the City Council has approved a \$90,270 renovation of our pool. At this time, that cost only includes a fiberglass liner in the pool, pressure testing the pipes, and adding the tile around the deck. Our bathhouse is also in need of updating to meet current standards, but this project will have to be done in phases. The City of Canistota greatly appreciates this opportunity to partner with Xcel Energy in improving the quality of life in our small City. Thank you!

#### Benefit to Community:

The Canistota City Council moved forward with funding this project without any guarantee of grant dollars because our pool has such a positive economic effect on our community. We provide employment for 8 -10 lifeguards and a manager. The first phase of sandblasting the pool has been completed, the City is waiting for the company to now return and construct the fiberglass liner. We have many students signed up for swimming lessons at our pool, many of those students are coming to Canistota from the surrounding communities to begin their lifelong love of water and the City of Canistota is proud to be a small part of providing that service to local and area families as the City continues to strive to improve the vitality and economic development of Canistota.







Community project description: After our park/playground was vandalized last year and some equipment was destroyed, the town was motivated to start a fundraising campaign to purchase and install new playground equipment. The existing equipment was extremely old (including the 1930s piece that was destroyed) and somewhat dangerous compared to today's standards. A new playground setup runs in the neighborhood of \$25,000. Installation, suitable, approved ground cover and fencing run another \$10,000. The town owns some vacant land and the plan is to install a new playground on that land. The new location is somewhat further away from the town tavern and will be a much more visible and safer place for the kids to play. We started this project last September. A huge fundraiser, with food, a live auction, a silent auction, a jail lockup (in Sherman's old town jail) and raffles with live music was held on July 30th of this year. The net proceeds from that one day's activities were over \$11,500, considerably over our hopes and expectations. We have received grants from Prairie Rose, Alliance Communications, Sioux Falls Area Community Foundation and private and business donations to bring our total raised and pledged thus far to over \$33,000. Community support and involvement has been nothing short of astonishing. We've even had residents of the rural areas around Sherman pitch in and help.

**Benefit to Community**: The benefit to the community will be a much safer place for the kids in town to play. Sherman has no sidewalks to speak of, and no paved streets. Places for kids to play and things for them to do are almost non-existent. It is our goal to change that in the next year. We have recently added a basketball court to our wish list of items to put in the new park. The cement pad there can also double as a skateboard area. A local concrete contractor has volunteered to pour the pad for just the cost of the materials. I should mention this contractor does in fact not live in town but is in support of our project to the level that he is willing to do this for us. Thank you for your consideration.
