Question:

Provide a cost estimates comparison for extending line for all locations in this filing with both providers.

Response:

- A. Sioux Valley Energy (SVE) has existing facilities adjacent to the southern property boundary of the Brandon industrial park property. Cost to extend facilities within the Brandon industrial park property would be dependent on facilities needed.
- B. Xcel Energy would need to spend in excess of \$1 million dollars in order to extend reliable 3-phase service to the Brandon industrial park property.
- C. In regards to the location described as Lots 1 and 2 of Block 2 Talsma 2nd Addition to the City of Sioux Falls in Section 21 of T101N, R50W in Minnehaha County (we'll refer to this at the apartment property):
 - I. SVE is in the planning stages for a project to extend 4500 feet of three phase line along 266th St, which will occur regardless of the proposed service territory exchange. Cost for that project is not included here. Cost to extend facilities from this planned project to the property boundary for the apartment property would be approximately \$20,000 to \$40,000, depending on the route. Extension of facilities to the apartment property at this time would require constructing facilities on private right-of-way, which would need to be acquired. Cost to extend facilities within the apartment property would be dependent on facilities needed.
- D. Xcel Energy has facilities directly adjacent to the apartment property that are readily available for extension. Internal property construction costs are dependent on facilities needed.
