Pursuant to Condition No. 31, Crowned Ridge Wind II, LLC ("Crowned Ridge II") provides the following post construction information for the transmission line that was completed and energized on July 31, 2020:

- 31. Within 90 days of the Project's completion, Applicant shall submit a report to the Commission that provides the following information:
 - a) As-built location of structures and route.

<u>Crowned Ridge II</u>: As-built maps providing the information required in subpart (a) are provided as Attachment A. One Crowned Ridge II transmission line structure required a shift greater than 5 feet owing to the avoidance of an underground fiber line. This shift occurred at structure #7 and resulted in a 14.19 feet shift along the project's centerline in the easterly direction. See Attachment B. No transmission structure height exceeds 120 feet, a span length exceedance of 1,000 feet or a foundation diameter exceedance of 9 feet.

b) The status of remedial activities for road damage, landowner property damage, crop damage, environmental damage, or any other damage resulting from construction activities.

<u>Crowned Ridge II</u>: Information regarding each category identified in subpart (b) is provided below:

- Road Damage: Remedial activities for road damages commenced in Q2 of 2020 and were completed in Q3 2020. Certificates of completion with the affected counties/townships are expected in Q4 of 2020 following post construction roads surveys.
- <u>Landowner Property Damage</u>: Property restoration activities commenced in Q2 of 2020 and are expected to be completed in Q3 of 2020.
- <u>Crop Damage</u>: Crowned Ridge II has commenced surveys for crop compensation packages in Q3 2020 and anticipates all sign-offs on crop compensation packages and payments to landowners to be completed in Q4 2020.
- Environmental Damage: Restoration of areas impacted by construction activities are expected to be completed in Q3 2020. No long-term environmental damage has occurred.
- c) A summary of known landowner complaints and Applicant's plan for resolving those complaints

Crowned Ridge II: There are no outstanding landowner complaints.
