I've owned my farm 42 years in Glenwood Township. I am not totally against the project but how it shows favoritism.

After the meeting in January at Clear Lake, I mentioned to your staff attorney Amanda Reiss, just way to much favoritism.

This is a little overwhelming, the project will include 24 towers within 1 3/4 miles of my farm site. Tower 112 is on my land, none of the other 23 towers owners live in Glenwood township. When I signed up, Glenwood Township was the southern border.

I have two pieces of land that is filed and the lines will go through both pieces, that I run silage cutters and trucks over, I know they will fix the file, but to get it correct is another issue.

In visiting with Doyle Thompson, in which he has 5 different parcels in Glenwood Township, to move tower 101 a couple rods south to share that tower. He seemed to be in agreement with the move. In energy energy was contacted but I do not get any answers from them. I wouldn't think it would be no big deal

if you look at tower # 80-81 is some of the favoritism that people are talking about, along with a couple other names on towers.

My Son Dean is one mile west of me, no towers for him other than to look at them on other land owners.
